



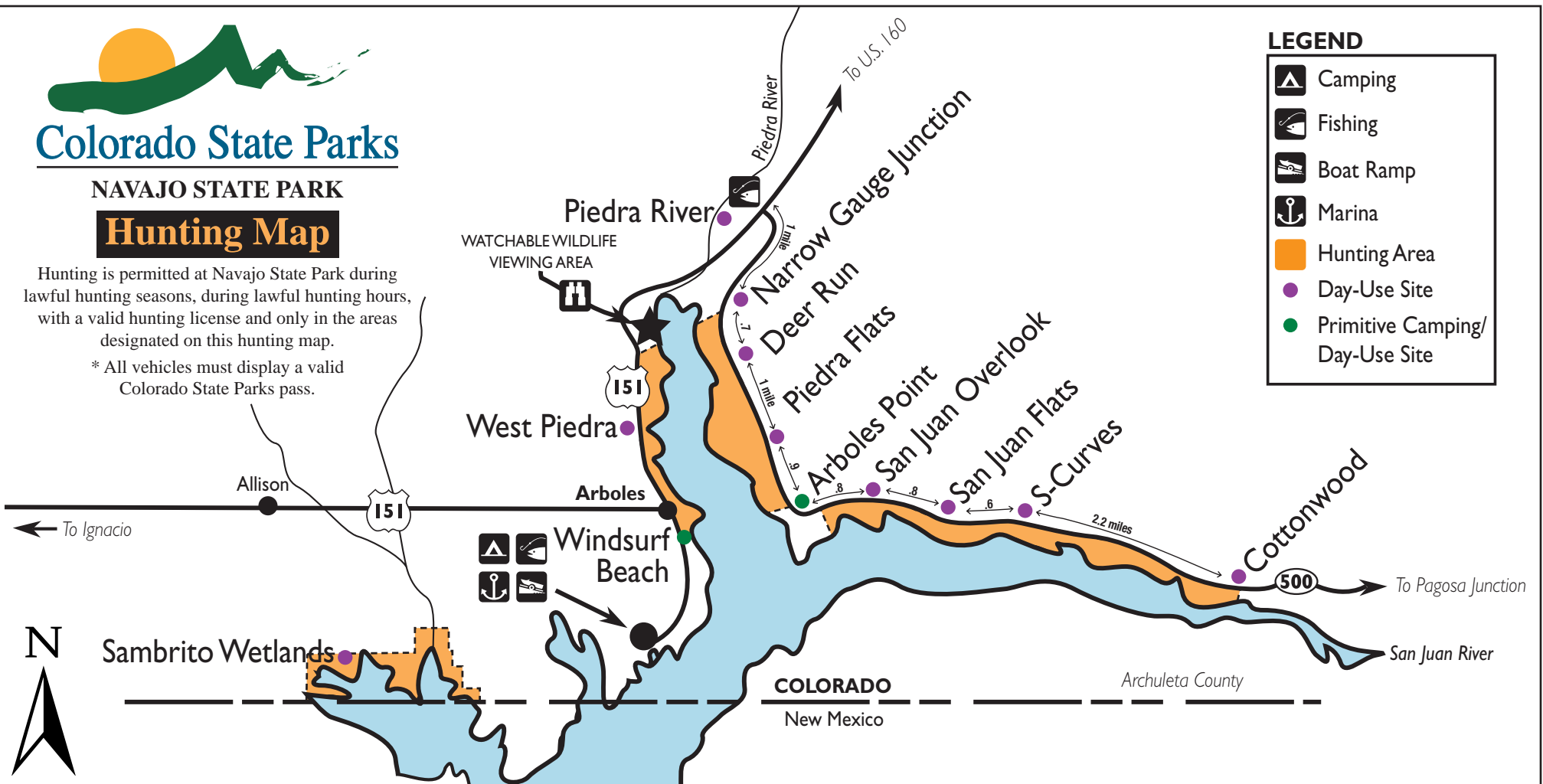
Colorado State Parks

NAVAJO STATE PARK

Hunting Map

Hunting is permitted at Navajo State Park during lawful hunting seasons, during lawful hunting hours, with a valid hunting license and only in the areas designated on this hunting map.

* All vehicles must display a valid Colorado State Parks pass.



Hunting is permitted ONLY in the following areas:

- From Windsurf Beach and Arboles Point, beginning where the Piedra River enters Navajo Reservoir, to the northern parking lot at the West Piedra Day-Use Area on the east side of the river, and the Deer Run Day-Use Area parking lot on the west side of the river. *At the West Piedra Day-Use Area, a metal gate on the Piedra Trail designates the Park's northern hunting area boundary. At the Deer Run Day-Use Area, the northern edge of the parking lot designates the Park's northern hunting area boundary.*
- From Arboles Point, beginning where the San Juan River enters Navajo Reservoir, southwest to the Cottonwood Day-Use Area. At the Cottonwood Day-Use Area, the southern edge of the parking lot designates the Park's southern hunting area boundary.
- Sambrito Wetlands Day-Use Area, within the boundary fencing, under the following restrictions:
 - Hunting is prohibited Mondays-Fridays from September 1st – October 15th.
- It is unlawful to hunt or discharge a firearm within 100 yards of any designated campground, picnic area, boat ramp, nature trail or study area.
- It is unlawful to hunt or discharge a firearm from a moving vessel.
- OHVs (ATVs or unlicensed dirt bikes) are prohibited in all park areas.
